Mr. LAI graduated with Professional Diploma in Physiotherapy from the HK Polytechnic in the early 1980s. He has worked for the Medical and Health Department, HK Government and Hospital Authority until his retirement as Department Manager (Physiotherapy) of Shatin Hospital in 2020. He has acquired MSc in Health Care Management (University of Wales); MBA in Public Service (University of Birmingham) and Bachelor of Laws (LL B) (University of London). Mr. LAI has special interests in neurological and geriatric rehabilitation.

Mr. LAI is a Life Member of Hong Kong Physiotherapy Association and has served as Vice-President from 2015 – 2019. He has been appointed as member of the PT Board (2009-2015) and the Supplementary Medical Professions Council (2013-2019). He has served as Chairman of the Preliminary Investigation Committee (PIC) of the PT Board and conducted meetings to investigate complaints against PT registrants, with the purpose to protect public interest and to maintain fairness to the registrants.

With his knowledge and experience in the PT Board and SMPC, he has been invited by HK Polytechnic University to teach the PT undergraduates on the topic of "Professional Ethics and Legal Issues" for the past 10 years. Mr. LAI is now working as a Part-time Professor of Practice in the Hong Kong Polytechnic University.
