ANNUAL REPORT OF PRESIDENT 2021-2022

Prof. Marco Y.C. PANG

This annual report provides a summary of the HKPA activities that took place between Apr 2021 and Mar 2022.

Executive Summary

The Annual General Meeting and Election of the Executive Committee were held on 12 Dec, 2022. I feel very honored to have been elected as the President of HKPA for a third term.

The COVID-19 pandemic was still affecting us in some ways in the past year. While we were all very adapted to holding meetings and seminars in an online mode, it was fortunate that we managed to host various activities in a hybrid mode, which had allowed us to meet with our members face-to-face.

The year of 2021 marked the 60th Anniversary of physiotherapy education in Hong Kong. We had organized a series of online seminars on different topics in relation to physiotherapy education throughout the year. In addition, we had hosted the World Physiotherapy Day event in September 2021, which was supported by the four academic institutions that provide physiotherapy education locally. The celebration of the 60th Anniversary of physiotherapy education culminated in our annual conference and gala dinner on 12 Dec 2021, which was co-organized with Sik Sik Yuen.

Another important development was related to direct access. Direct access to physiotherapy service is one of the recommendations made in the Chief Executive's Policy Address 2021. Since the Policy Address was announced in Oct 2021, HKPA has been very active in hosting discussion forums to gather opinions from the physiotherapy community. HKPA has also played a critical role in preparing the direct access proposal for submission to the Physiotherapists Board.

Apart from direct access, we were faced with two major professional issues. One was related to the comments made by a chiropractor in a TV program, which was considered to be inappropriate by many of our physiotherapy colleagues. HKPA took prompt actions to defend our profession and make our stance clear. Another important issue was the high attrition rate of physiotherapists in Hospital Authority. HKPA had issued two letters to the Management of Hospital Authority to raise our concerns.

The Finance Report shows a significant increase in asset over the past financial year. The student membership continued to increase, thanks to the concerted effort of our Executive Committee members.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank Dr. Patrick L. T. WONG as our Honorary Auditor, and Mr. Bronco BUT as our Honorary Legal Advisor for their contribution to our Association. My sincere gratitude to all Executive Committee members of the HKPA and also the Chairpersons and Executive Committee members of the Specialty Groups for their devotion to HKPA. Finally, I would like to thank our members for their trust, and let's work together to build a stronger physiotherapy community.

Executive Committee Meetings

The Executive Committee held a total of 4 meetings during the report period (17 Jul 2021, 29 Jan 2022, 7 May 2022). All three meetings were held online due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Professional Development Subcommittee is responsible for overseeing the professional development activities of the Hong Kong Physiotherapy Association (HKPA). Its main functions include holding the annual Specialty Groups / Working Groups Meeting with the chairpersons and executive members of Specialty Groups (SG) and Working Groups (WG) to discuss issues related to the planning and organization of professional development activities of HKPA.

A. Annual Specialty Group Meeting and Spring Dinner

The 19th SG/WG meeting (2022) was held on 13 Jul 2022 under the 5th wave of Covid-19. To avoid social gathering, an online meeting was conducted this year again. Moreover, the HKPA spring dinner gathering was also suspended due to the COVID situation. In the meeting, the guidelines on sponsorship for attending international meetings and the conversion of APTWG to APTSG (pending for endorsement) were reported.

B. Training Courses

The 60th Anniversary of Physiotherapy Education in Hong Kong Seminar Series:

To celebrate 60th anniversary of physiotherapy education in Hong Kong, the HKPA had conducted 5 seminars and 1 special seminar from 2 Mar to 20 Jul 2021. Various influential and remarkable speakers from World Physiotherapy, local and overseas educational bodies and physiotherapy associations were invited to share online on the development of physiotherapy education.

C. Continuing Professional Development Scheme

The Continuing Professional Development (CPD) program has been providing our members an assorted and extensive learning opportunity from basic knowledge to specialized skills.

Last year, a total of 240 courses were accredited in our CPD program. The total contact duration of all accredited CPD activities were 5478 hours (Table 1). Online program is still in majority among all CPD activities. Therefore, our members could enjoy learning opportunities from different training institutes and academic organizations under the COVID-19 outbreak.

D. Acupuncture Accreditation Scheme

The Acupuncture Accreditation Board of the HKPA was established in 1999 with the intent to uphold the standard of acupuncture practice by physiotherapists and to assure related quality of service delivered to clients. From Jan 2021 to Mar 2022, there were 199 registered physiotherapists accredited by the Acupuncture Accreditation Board. Among these 199 registered physiotherapists, 62 were members of the HKPA.

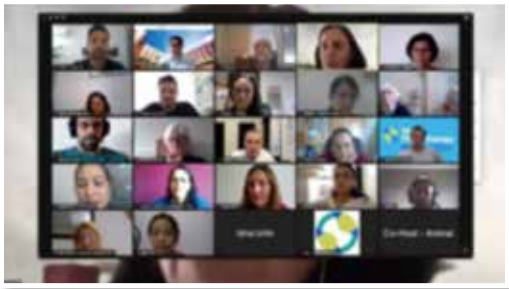


The Way Forward
