Under my leadership for the last term (2021-23), HKPA has achieved the following:

- The World Physiotherapy Asia Western Pacific Regional Congress was successfully held in June 2022 and was attended by 545 people from 32 countries/territories.
- A major review of the Memorandum & Articles of Association (M & A) of HKPA was initiated to ensure good governance and reduce the risk on HKPA (revised M & A subsequently approved at the Extraordinary General Meeting in March 2023).
- I have been playing an important role in preparing the direct access proposal, which was submitted to the Physiotherapists Board in late 2022, and then deliberated at the Supplementary Medical Professions Council Meeting in early 2023.
- HKPA membership continued to increase, reaching 2339 members.
- HKPA has signed MOU with Australian Physiotherapy Association, Korean Physical Therapy Association and Macau Physical Therapists Association.
- To commemorate the 60th Anniversary of HKPA, a series of public lectures were held that enabled us to reach many people from the general public, thereby increasing the visibility of the physiotherapy profession.
- Received the World Physiotherapy International Service Award for Research in 2023.
- As Editor-in-Chief of Hong Kong Physiotherapy Journal for the past 12 years (HKPJ, official journal of HKPA), HKPJ received its first impact factor (1.5) in 2023.
- Elected as the Chair of World Physiotherapy Asia Western Pacific Region Executive Committee (2023-27).

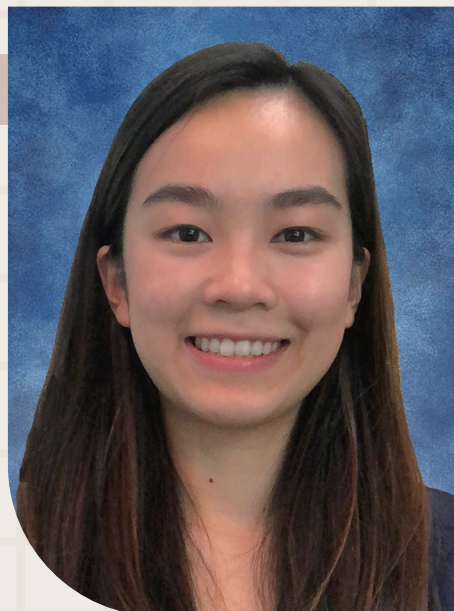


Dr. NGAI Pui Ching, Shirley
